RULES, REGULATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS

O COUNT

Any person wishing to tap into a Scioto County Sanitary Sewer System shall comply with the following rules:

- 1. Complete an application with sketch at the Sanitary Engineering Department, Room 104 of the Scioto County Courthouse, 602 Seventh Street, Portsmouth
- 2. Pay a \$425 tap-in fee
- 3. Pay a \$25 permit and inspection fee
- 4. We will then locate your tap and furnish any additional information we have on the tap
- 5. The owner of each house is responsible for the installation and expense of the building sewer, from the building to the sewer tap or public sewer
- 6. No person shall connect any storm water, roof runoff, surface water, or subsurface drainage to any sanitary sewer
- 7. Approved pipe material PVC #3034, Schedule 40 #2665 or better
- 8. All joints shall be sealed against leaks
- 9. Minimum size shall be four inch (4") pipe
- 10. Minimum slope shall be one-eighth inch (1/8") per foot
- 11. Minimum depth shall be two foot (2') of cover
- 12. Notify the Sanitary Engineer, 355-8249 when the building sewer has been laid and ready for inspection, before it is covered or back filled. No inspections will be done until the application has been made and fees paid
- 13. Excavation shall be guarded with barricades to protect the public
- 14. Any person failing to comply with these rules shall be subject to legal action by the County Prosecutor
